
She works predominately with mixed-painting mediums, including encaustics, resin, oil and acrylics. Her process focuses on deconstruction, transformation, and reconstruction. Her artworks are visual reconstructions of everyday materials, including books, magazines and tissue. She has an intentional engagement of the sense of touch, and the finished works create a textural and abstract presence of the virtually unrecognizable materials contained within.

An important step in her process is finding the right materials - The first phase of the process starts with finding a material to create her own unique canvas. For example, she has

a series made from books, one made from magazine papers, one from tissue papers, and one from a traditional canvas. Sometimes inspired to paint on a traditional encaustic board or canvas. To see more of her beautiful work check her out at: .
